There have been many questions for almost 2000 years about the Antichrist and many other things that people link with the book of Revelation. Our Evangelical brothers and sisters want us to believe that the Antichrist is a singular individual coming in the future. However, “the spirit of the antichrist” has been around for much longer. In fact, it has been around from the beginning.

“The spirit of the antichrist” is anything or anyone who does not confess Jesus. Satan is the ultimate “spirit of the antichrist,” who sought to derail all of creation by causing Adam and Eve to fall into sin. His most infamous question, “Did God actually say?” (Genesis 3:1), echoes throughout all history with any question that seeks to create doubt about God’s goodness.

Anything and everything that doesn’t confess Jesus as “the Christ, the Son of the living God” (Matthew 16:16), is from Satan.

Today, we have all kinds of different ways that Satan is using his “spirit of the antichrist” to undermine the Church. The only way to combat this spirit is with the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit who comes to you in Word and Sacrament.

When you were confirmed, you vowed to hear the Word of God faithfully and to live according to it “even to death.” “The spirit of the antichrist” seeks your death. God’s Word gives life. This has been ever since the beginning. It continues now. It will be here until Christ returns.

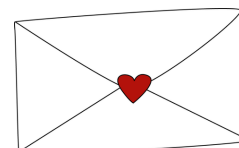

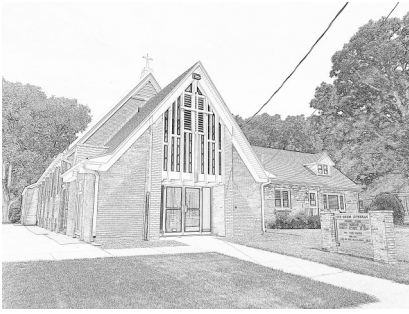
Vacation Bible School
